

Dr. Stefan Bandlitz is an optometrist and received his Master of Science in Clinical Optometry from Pennsylvania College of Optometry in Philadelphia, USA and his PhD degree from Cardiff University, Wales, UK. He is a Senior Lecturer at the Höhere Fachschule für Augenoptik (Cologne School of Optometry), Germany with teaching areas including contact lens fitting, clinical optometry and statistics. He acts as a scientific advisor for the Kuratorium Gutes Sehen e.V. and for the scientific committee of the Zentralverband der Augenoptiker und Optometristen in Germany. Stefan is an examiner for the European Diploma in Optometry (ECOO) and for the Optometrist (ZVA, HWK).

Furthermore, Dr. Bandlitz is a researcher at the Anterior Eye Research Group, Aston University, Birmingham, UK. He is a Fellow of the College of Optometrists (FCOptom), Fellow of the International Association of Contact Lens Educators (FIACLE) and Fellow of the British Contact Lens Association (FBCLA). Dr. Bandlitz is a known speaker at national and international meetings and has authored and co-authored around 70 publications (including peer-reviewed, textbook chapters, non-peer-reviewed etc.). His current research areas include contact lenses, anterior eye imaging, the ocular surface, and the tear film.
